Virtual PASS THE BASKET Form

Kingman AA Intergroup met on 3.17.20 in an emergency meeting by phone in response to the Covid-19 crisis. Intergroup voted to post schedules and information for any groups that choose to switch to virtual meetings during the crisis. If groups decide to go virtual, Intergroup will corordinate their efforts, list their meetings, and collect money for their "baskets" to give to the group's treasurers. Even though the Northern Lights Hall has now closed, we want to ensure that groups still pay their rent in the interim so that our Hall can pay the ongoing bills.

Suggestion for Contributions

Count the number of meetings you would normally attend in a week and the amount you would put in the basket, times it by 4, and donate for a month. Example. If you attended the 9am on Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday and put in \$1, that is \$3 times 4 weeks and equals \$12. If you also normally attend the Monday Lunch Bunch and put in \$2, (times 4 equals \$8)- \$12 plus \$8 equals \$20, so you would write a check for \$20, designate the amount for each group below and Intergroup will distribute the funds to the treasurer of each group.

Contribute any amount you like, of course, to the virtual basket. We only recommend using this formula because it makes the bookkeeping easier and your group can continue to pay their monthly rent without running out of funds.
